Come along to watch Tom Wilson's 'The Graveyard Shift' on either:

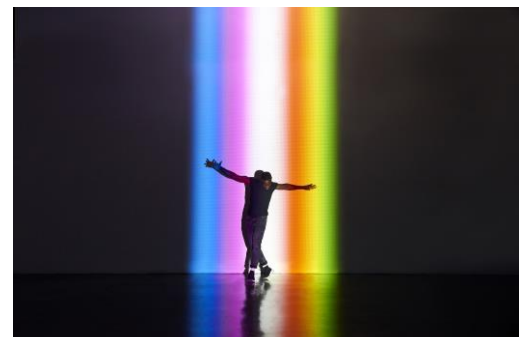
