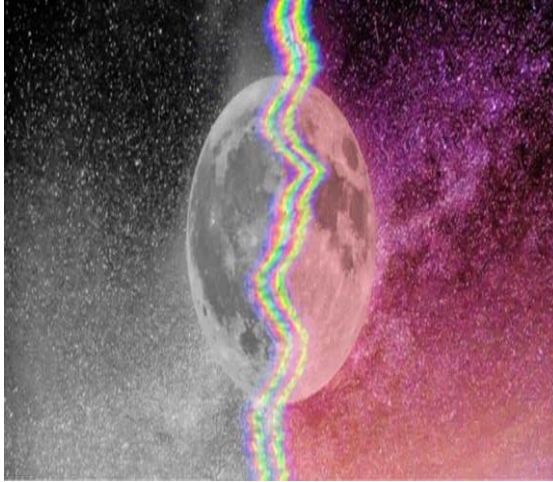

Location: Jack Hylton Room

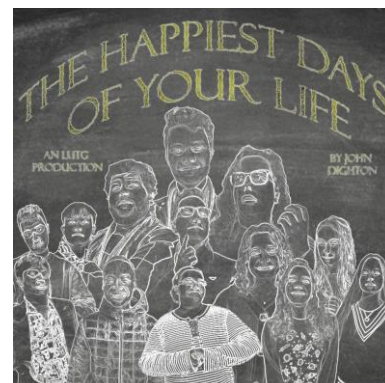
The Happiest Days of Your Life – 18th, 19th March
